Starting tomorrow January 11– January 24 all General Trass High School students grades 9th -12th will transition back to virtual learning. Currently, we have insufficient staffing to address our in-person academic needs due to COVID related concerns.

Great care and thought went into this decision; however, we regret the hardships this will cause for some of our families. At this time, we believe that this is the right step to take for the health and safety of our students, families, employees, and the community at large.

During this time, students will be required to log on to each class. Attendance laws and requirements will be strictly enforced. To prevent academic regression and the possibility of your child becoming truant, please ensure your child logs in daily and completes all assignments. In-person classes are scheduled to resume on Monday, January 24.

Please continue to monitor your child's health. Seek guidance from your medical provider as soon as possible, if your child presents any symptom of COVID-19. If your child or a household member tests positive, it is very important that your child's school is aware. If you have any questions, please contact your child's school.
