Bullying Awareness and Prevention Training

Every employee in the district is required to complete Bullying Awareness/Prevention Training.

Suicide Awareness Training

All certified employees, front office personnel, and paraprofessionals are required to take Suicide Awareness Training.

Mandatory Reporter Training

This training is self-paced. The training includes video clips and interactive activities. You must watch the video and complete the activities and the test before training will be considered complete.

Teen Dating Violence

All school employees having contact with students in grades 7-12

- Provide age and grade appropriate classroom instruction relative to dating violence for students in grades seven through twelve.
- Provide instruction to all school employees having contact with students in such grades relative to the definition of dating violence, dating violence warning signs, and how to properly address suspected or reported dating violence involving students.

Bullying Awareness/Prevention Training – Instructions

Every employee of the East Carroll Parish School District is required to complete 2 hours of bullying awareness/prevention training annually.

- New classroom instructors of the East Carroll Parish School District are required to complete 4 hours of bullying awareness/prevention training their first year of work. After year 1, classroom instructors will then be on the 2 hours per year rotation.
- Teachers who are new to ECPSD but have worked previously in other districts and can provide documentation of previous training may adhere to the 2 hour per year requirements.

If you do not complete the quiz you will have not shown completion. Once you complete the training listed, you are done with Bullying Awareness/Prevention training for the 2021-2022 school year.
